Each year at the State Field Tournament the officers meet to nominate for offices whose term ends that year and to make any proposals to be discussed. The election of officers and voting on the proposals are done at the Fall Meeting in November.

Votes will need to be in no later than November 6, 2006 to make sure they are received and counted.

Proposals made at the August 12, 2006 meeting are as follows:

- 1.) All state shoot fees be raised to \$20.00 per single shooter, family \$35.00 and cubs \$15.00 with \$5.00 per shooter going to the host club.
- 2.) It was proposed we do some research on shooting NASP (National Archery In The Schools) and how to adopt them to our classes.
- 3.) The term of the Kentucky NFAA Director will be two years to take effect on March 1 of the election year. Reasoning for this is our annual meeting is in late November, this is not enough time to get in compliance.

These are the proposals made to be on the agenda in the fall. Please let your club representative or an officer know if you have an opinion on these matters, or if there is something that you feel needs to be done. I encourage all officers and any club representative to be at the meeting. It is always good to have ideas from the different clubs of the state meeting to make the whole K.A.A. a better organization to promote archery. The meeting will be at Pleasant Valley Archery in Providence, KY on November 25, 2006 at 12:00 noon central time.

It's time to think about fall indoor starting up, just a couple of months away. I have not spoken to anyone from Pleasant Valley, but I'm sure they will start their Saturday night shoots

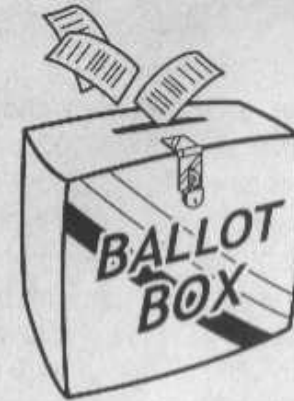
